WHAT DO WE REQUIRE?

We are accredited and licensed through the State of South Dakota and National Lutheran Schools. Staff will consist of a certified teacher plus one or two assistants, depending on class size. Children must be three years of age and toilet trained. Parents/guardians must complete an enrollment form, pay a \$25 materials fee, provide a copy of birth certificate and current immunization records. Occasional activity/supply fees may be required.

Students enrolled in our Summer Program will be given the opportunity to participate in the Hot Springs Public Library Reading Program as well as field trips and other community programs.
